<u>Habitat hunt</u> - Whilst enjoying your local waterway, how many different habitats can you spot? What wildlife did you see?

<u>Plastic challenge -</u> Visit your local river or canal bank and, with adult supervision, carefully collect any plastic you see. Dispose of it safely and sustainably by taking it home to recycle. You can take pictures of your pick to encourage others to get involved! Make sure that you

have suitable clothing or footwear and please wear gloves and/or use a litter pick to collect any rubbish. Do not collect it with your bare hands!

<u>Walk To School –</u> We would like to encourage as many families as possible to leave their cars at home on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2024 and travel to school on foot or by bike. If non-
