Dear Parents and Carers,



We have been asked to take part in this year's Remembrance Day by contributing to a large display of poppies in St. Mary's Church, Chesterton. As you may know, our School Council always helps to raise funds for the Royal British Legion through the sale of poppies and other items. However, we thought this would be another way to mark the occasion in our local community.

We are asking children to create a poppy (or as many as they would like). We would ask for mostly red poppies (for soldiers), but it would be lovely to also have some purple poppies (to honour animals lost in military service). There is no set size or design; it may be easiest to create something on paper or card in two dimensions (not too small please), but if you are feeling

ambitious and can come up with a 3-D design, we would like to see those too. There are some great 'how to' videos and instruction sheets available online. If you would like to create your design on a template sheet

To allow the display to be created in good time before Remembrance Sunday, please hand your finished poppies (with names attached) in to the school office by Monday 21st October. There will be house points awarded for every entry. With the help of the Collective Worship Council, we will then judge winning entries for each class.

All entries will be submitted to the Parish Council and winners will be announced in our special Remembrance Collective Worship after half-term.
