English:

We will start the term by looking at two fiction books: 'Hello Lighthouse' and 'One Plastic Bag'. Through these stories, we will explore environmental and recycling themes and we will begin to learn about persuasive language as we write letters and adverts.

Later on in the term, we will move on to a non-fiction focus, as we create fact-files and reports about sharks.

We will also enjoy some stories about pirates as we head further into the term. We will explore the characters and write stories about their adventures.

Art

The children will be learning about and using textiles techniques, such as weaving and colour dying, and they will be using their skills to create artwork with a seaside theme.

During Arts Week, the focus will turn towards a 'flowers' theme, as we work on our sculpting skills.

STEM

Science
In Science, the children will be learning about living things and their habitats. They will be thinking about what plants and animals need to survive.

Computing:

This term, children will be focusing on algorithms - giving clear and precise instructions, sequencing instructions and programming a Bee-Bot!

Design and Technology

In D.T. the children will be completing a cooking and nutrition unit. They will learn about making various seaside snacks and we will be focusing on our cutting and presentation skills.

As we move through the term, we will be focusing on telling the time, looking at statistics and exploring position and direction.
