### Curriculum

### Homework

The 'Enriching Learning' homework sheet will be posted on the school website with the expectation that one piece is to be returned to school, completed, every **Monday**. This can include playing the games on the Times Tables Rock Stars app/website.

Please look out for the weekly spelling/phonics pattern sheets, which will be provided by your child's spelling/phonics teacher every **Thursday**. Your child will be tested on words connected to this rule or pattern on the following **Thursday**.



Reading records will be checked every **Monday**. Please try to encourage your child to read regularly throughout the week. 5-10 minutes of extra reading daily, with an adult or independently, will really support the work that we do within school. Please make sure that each entry includes the title, page numbers and a comment.

### P.E.

In Term 5, the children will have their P.E. lesson on Thursday. In Term 6, the children will have their P.E. lessons on Monday and Tuesday.

P.E. kits should remain **in school at all times**, apart from when needing to be taken home to be washed. This is especially important for this term as our sessions may change to ensure that we have access to the May Pole! All children should have indoor and outdoor kit, including a house t-shirt, shorts, tracksuit bottoms, a warm long-sleeved top and trainers. **Please make sure that your child's P.E. kit and school uniform is clearly named.**
